

# -78 Unplanned Return to the Operating/Procedure Room by the Same Physician Following the Initial Procedure for a Related Procedure During the Postoperative Period

Used to indicate that a related procedure was performed during the postoperative period of the initial procedure (unplanned procedure following initial procedure).

### **Product Information**

The information outlined below applies to Aspirus Medicare Advantage products.

#### **Payment Information**

- The allowed amount is based on the intra-operative percentage listed in the "INTRA OP" field of the CMS Medicare Physician Fee Schedule Relative Value File (MPFSRVF) for services with a 90- or 10-day global period.
- A new postoperative period *does not* begin when using the -78 modifier.

#### **Appropriate Use**

- The-78 modifier describes a related, yet unplanned return to the operating room or procedure room during the global period of the initial procedure by the same physician.
- The -78 modifier is only valid when billed with surgical codes and the procedure is performed within the global period of the initial procedure.

#### Inappropriate Use

• When the surgery performed is unrelated to the initial procedure.
